

2024 Starling Match Racing National Championships Eligibility and Region Definition

To be eligible to represent a region a competitor shall be under the age of 19 on the first day of the Starling Match Racing National Championships and have been a member of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand within the relevant region.

Each region may nominate one entrant.

Any region that does not nominate an entrant by 24 March 2024 shall forfeit its place.

The Starling Class Association (SCA) will select entrants for the wildcard place and to fill any places forfeited. In selecting the entrants, the SCA will have regard to:

- encouraging participation of female sailors;
- regional diversity (selecting competitors from regions bordering forfeited places);
and
- fleet strength (selecting sailors with strong performances in Starling match racing, 420 teams racing, and Starling fleet racing).

Candidates that have entered a regional trial (where available) will generally be preferred.

Sailors finishing in second place in a regional trial will automatically be considered for a wildcard place. Other sailors that wish to apply for a wildcard place should contact Paul Webber (paul.webber@wedgewoodwhite.com) before 24 March 2024.
